



E - Salvation Scriptures.

(Scriptures from KJV unless noted otherwise)

Isaiah 64:6

⁶ But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away. (KJV)

Luke 13:3

³ I tell you, No: but, except you repent, you shall all likewise perish. (KJV)

2 Cor. 5:21

²¹ For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. (KJV)

Rom. 3:23

²³ For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; ²⁴ Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: (KJV)

Rom. 5:8-11

⁸ But God commends his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. ⁹ Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. ¹⁰ For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life. ¹¹ And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement (reconciliation). (KJV)

Rom. 5:12

¹² Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: (KJV)

Rom. 5:17-21

¹⁷ For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.) ¹⁸ Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life. ¹⁹ For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous. ²⁰ Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin

abounded, grace did much more abound: ²¹ That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord. (KJV)

Rom. 6:23

²³ For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. (KJV)

Heb. 9:27-28

²⁷ And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment: ²⁸ So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation. (KJV)

Rev.14:11

¹¹ And the smoke of their torment ascends up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receives the mark of his name. (KJV)

John 3:3

³ Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. (KJV)

Gal. 2:16

¹⁶ Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified. (KJV)

Rom. 3:28

²⁸ Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law. (KJV)

Eph. 1:13

¹³ In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, (KJV)



E - Salvation Scriptures.

Eph.2:8-10

⁸ For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: ⁹ Not of works, lest any man should boast. ¹⁰ For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them. (KJV)

Luke 4:18:19

¹⁸ The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the broken hearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, ¹⁹ To preach the acceptable year of the Lord. (KJV)

John 1:12-13

¹² But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: ¹³ Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. (KJV)

John 3:16-17

¹⁶ For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. ¹⁷ For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. (KJV)

John 10:10

¹⁰ The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. (KJV)

John 11:25-26

²⁵ Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: ²⁶ And whosoever lives and believeth in me shall never die. Believe you this? (KJV)

John 14:6-7

⁶ Jesus said unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. ⁷ If you had known me, you should have known my Father also: and from henceforth you know him, and have seen him. (KJV)

Acts 4:10-12

¹⁰ Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him does this man stand here before you whole. ¹¹ This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. ¹² Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. (KJV)

Acts 16:31

³¹ And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you shalt be saved, and your house. (KJV)

Rom. 1:16-17

¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. ¹⁷ For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith. (KJV)

Rom. 10:9-10

⁹ That if you shalt confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in your heart that God hath raised him from the dead, you shalt be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. (KJV)

Rom. 10:12-13

¹² For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. ¹³ For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. (KJV)

2 Cor. 5:17

¹⁷ Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. (KJV)



E - Salvation Scriptures.

Col.1:13-15

¹³ Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: ¹⁴ In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins: ¹⁵ Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: (KJV)

Col.1:18

¹⁸ And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the pre-eminence. (KJV)

1 Tim. 1:15

¹⁵ This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief. (KJV)

1Tim. 2:5

⁵ For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; (KJV)

Titus 3:5

⁵ Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; (KJV)

Heb. 13:20

²⁰ Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, (KJV)

Rev. 3:20

²⁰ Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. (KJV)

How does it go from here?

- Get a Bible and read it daily to get to know Jesus.
- Talk to God in simple prayer.

What Must I Do To be Saved

1. Admit that you are a sinner:

The Bible says, "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God" (KJV) **(Rom.3:23)**

2. Know that God has already provided for your salvation:

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" (KJV) **(John 3:16)**

3. Know that you can not save yourself:

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; (KJV) **(Titus 3:5)**

4. Repent of your sins:

³ I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, you shall all likewise perish. (KJV) **(Luke 13:3)**

5. Ask Jesus Christ to save you:

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. **(Rom.10:13)**, ³¹ And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. (KJV) **(Acts 16:31)**

6. Confess Jesus before men:

⁹ That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. (KJV) **(Rom. 10:9-10)**

What To Pray

"Dear Father, I know that I am a sinner and need forgiveness. I believe that Christ Jesus died for my sins. I am willing to turn from my sins. I now invite Jesus Christ to come into my heart and life as my personal saviour. I am willing, by God's Grace to follow and obey Christ as the Lord of my life – Amen"
