



## K - Prosperity Scriptures.

### Note:

1. It is important in the life of a believer that we give absolute authority to the "Word of God" and above anything else, no matter what our 5 senses (hearing, seeing, tasting, smelling and feeling) want to convey to us. This applies to every life situation we are in, including healing. Remember, we walk by faith not by sight. It is extremely important for us to learn to confess the "Word of God" about and over our natural circumstances. Even God did not say what he saw (darkness) in the creation of the world, but spoke out what he wanted (light) to create. As a born-again believer, Jesus has already healed, freed, and delivered you from every illness and affliction, with or without names.

2. Whenever you read about the ministry of Jesus in the scriptures, pay special attention to the words "all" and "every."

### Prosperity Scriptures

(Scriptures NKJV)

#### **Genesis 13:2, 5-6, 14-17**

<sup>2</sup> And Abram was very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold. <sup>5</sup> And Lot also, which went with Abram, had flocks, and herds, and tents. <sup>6</sup> And the land was not able to bear them, that they might dwell together: for their substance was great, so that they could not dwell together. <sup>14</sup> And the Lord said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now your eyes, and look from the place where you art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward: <sup>15</sup> For all the land which you see, to you will I give it, and to your seed for ever. <sup>16</sup> And I will make your seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall your seed also be numbered. <sup>17</sup> Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto you. (KJV)

#### **Gen 14:22-23**

<sup>22</sup> And Abram said to the king of Sodom, I have lift up my hand unto the Lord, the most high God, the possessor of heaven and earth, <sup>23</sup> That I will not take from a thread even to a shoe latchet (sandal strap), and that I will not take anything that is yours, lest you should say, I have made Abram rich: (KJV)

#### **Genesis 17:5-7**

<sup>5</sup> Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made you. <sup>6</sup> And I will make you exceeding fruitful, and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come out of you. <sup>7</sup> And I will establish my covenant between me and you and your seed after you in their generations for an

everlasting covenant, to be a God unto you, and to your seed after you. (KJV)

#### **Genesis 26:12-14**

<sup>12</sup> Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundredfold: and the Lord blessed him. <sup>13</sup> And the man waxed great, and went forward, and grew until he became very great: <sup>14</sup> For he had possession of flocks, and possession of herds, and great store of servants: and the Philistines envied him. (KJV)

#### **Genesis 30:43**

<sup>43</sup> And the man increased exceedingly, and had much cattle, and maidservants, and menservants, and camels, and asses. (KJV)

#### **Genesis 39:2-3**

<sup>2</sup> And the Lord was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian. <sup>3</sup> And his master saw that the Lord was with him, and that the Lord made all that he did to prosper in his hand. (KJV)

#### **Exodus 3:7-8**

<sup>7</sup> And the Lord said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows; <sup>8</sup> And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites. (KJV)

#### **Deut.8:18**

<sup>18</sup> **But you shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is he that gives you power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he swore unto thy fathers, as it is this day.** (KJV)

#### **Deut. 28:1-2**

<sup>1</sup> And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command you this day, that the Lord thy God will set you on high above all nations of the earth: <sup>2</sup> And all these blessings shall come on you, and overtake you, if you shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God. (KJV)

<sup>19</sup> I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both you and your seed may live: <sup>20</sup> That you may love the Lord thy God, and that you may obey his voice, and that you may cleave unto him: for he is your life, and the length of your days: that you may dwell in the land which the Lord swore unto your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them. (KJV)

### Joshua 1:5

<sup>5</sup> There shall not any man be able to stand before you all the days of your life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with you: I will not fail you, nor forsake you. (KJV)

<sup>5</sup> And he sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the Lord, God made him to prosper. (KJV)

### Psalm 1:3

<sup>3</sup> And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he does shall prosper. (KJV)

### Psalm 35:27

<sup>27</sup> Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, **which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.** (KJV)

### Psalm 37:25-26

<sup>25</sup> I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread. <sup>26</sup> He is ever merciful, and lends; **and his seed is blessed.** (KJV)

### Proverbs 3:9-10

<sup>9</sup> **Honour the Lord with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase:** <sup>10</sup> So shall your barns be filled with plenty, and your presses shall burst out with new wine. (KJV)

### Proverbs 10:22

<sup>22</sup> The blessing of the Lord, it makes rich, and he adds no sorrow with it. (KJV)

<sup>19</sup> If you be willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land: (KJV)

<sup>15</sup> I, even I, have spoken; yea, I have called him: I have brought him, **and he shall make his way prosperous.**<sup>17</sup> Thus says the Lord, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; **I am the Lord thy God which teaches you to profit,** which leads you by the way that you should go. (KJV)

### Isaiah 55:11

<sup>11</sup> So shall my word be that goes forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. (KJV)

<sup>7</sup> And I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, says the Lord of hosts. <sup>8</sup> The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, says the Lord of hosts. <sup>9</sup> The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, says the Lord of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, says the Lord of hosts. (KJV)

### Malachi 3:10-12

<sup>10</sup> Bring you all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, says the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. <sup>11</sup> And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, says the Lord of hosts. <sup>12</sup> And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightful land, says the Lord of hosts. (KJV)

### Matthew 6:19-21

<sup>19</sup> Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: <sup>20</sup> But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: <sup>21</sup> For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also (KJV)

### Matthew 6:25-26, 28, 30, 32-33

<sup>25</sup> Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what you shall eat, or what you shall drink; nor yet for your body, what you shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? <sup>26</sup> Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are ye not much better than they? <sup>28</sup> And why take you thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin <sup>30</sup> Wherefore, if God so clothes the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? <sup>32</sup> (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knows that you have need of all these things. <sup>33</sup> But seek you first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. (KJV)

### Mark 4:19

<sup>19</sup> And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful. (KJV)

### Mark 4:20-25

<sup>20</sup> And these are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred. <sup>21</sup> And he said unto them, Is a candle brought to be put under a bushel, or under a bed? and not to be set on a candlestick? <sup>22</sup> For there is nothing hid, which shall not be manifested; neither was any thing kept secret, but that it should come abroad. <sup>23</sup> If any man have ears to hear, let him hear. <sup>24</sup> And he said unto them, Take heed what you hear: with what measure you mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given. <sup>25</sup> For he that hath, to him shall be given: and he that hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he hath. (KJV)

### Mark 4:23-29

<sup>23</sup> If any man have ears to hear, let him hear. <sup>24</sup> And he said unto them, Take heed what you hear: with what measure you mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given. <sup>25</sup> For he that has, to him shall be given: and he that has not, from him shall be taken even that which he hath. <sup>26</sup> And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground; <sup>27</sup> And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knows not how. <sup>28</sup> For the earth brings forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear. <sup>29</sup> But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he puts in the sickle, because the harvest is come. (KJV)

<sup>38</sup> Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that you mete withal it shall be measured to you again. (KJV)

<sup>13</sup> Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangs on a tree: <sup>14</sup> That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. (KJV)

(KJV)
